



















A first impression

In the beautiful Tuscan hills bordering the provinces of Florence, Pisa and Siena, near the regions of Volterra and San Gimignano, lies this beautiful farmhouse, nestled in a natural, unspoiled and rugged setting. In this part of Tuscany we find fragments of history and the past: the Etruscans, the Lombards, the Maritime Republic of Pisa, the Knights Templar and the noble families of the Grand Duchy of Tuscany. The property consists of two units and the main farmhouse consisting of 6 apartments: 4 two-room apartments of 50 sgm and 2 two-room apartments of 75 sqm, barn with 2 three-room apartments of 80 sqm renovated and furnished in the original country style. The 50 sqm apartments consist of living room/kitchen, double bedroom, bathroom with shower, beamed ceilings and private gazebo with barbecue. The farmhouse is surrounded by a green area of 7000 square meters with private covered parking, bocce court, playground, table tennis and a very large swimming pool among olive, oleander and fruit trees. The location of the farmhouse is ideal for visiting the most important cultural and artistic centers of Tuscany such as Florence, Siena, Pisa, Lucca, San Gimignano, Volterra and the sea is only 45 km away by car.
